





Due to the opening of new venues and the introduction of new SIPMU seminars and courses, we would like to remind you and underline here the basic rules for SIPMU courses in relation to the SIPMU Statute, SIPMU Code of Ethics and ESH Code of Ethics. Regulations on access to courses in clinical hypnosis:

Courses devoted to the teaching and therapeutic practice of clinical hypnosis must be strictly reserved for graduates in Medicine, Psychology, and Dentistry; no students or other persons may be admitted to these courses.

SIPMU lecturers of Clinical Hypnosis must have a degree in Medicine, Psychology, or Dentistry and be recognised by the SIPMU Statutes as hypnotherapists.

SIPMU lecturers are not permitted to practise hypnosis, either didactically or therapeutically, during courses open to the public sponsored by SIPMU, as in such contexts the legal and therapeutic responsibility would fall partly on SIPMU. SIPMU in fact by statute is a Scientific Society for training and not dedicated to therapy, as a society that deals with therapy involves much more complex legal risks and the need to have insurance for professional risks.

Limitations in courses open to the public or to health professionals: SIPMU courses intended for all health professions or open to the public may not include the therapeutic practice of hypnosis on individuals nor the practical teaching of clinical hypnosis.

Requirements for lecturers of SIPMU-sponsored courses:

For clinical hypnosis courses: lecturers must hold a degree in Medicine, Psychology or Dentistry and be recognised by the SIPMU Statute as hypnotherapists.

For humanistic courses open to other health professions: teachers of courses sponsored by SIPMU may also be graduates in the health or course-specific disciplines

For courses open to other health professions a SIPMU lecturer with a degree in Medicine, Psychology or Dentistry and a SIPMU member is required.

Criteria for sponsoring SIPMU courses:

- ☐ SIPMU can sponsor clinical hypnosis courses aimed at doctors, psychologists, dentists, conducted by SIPMU members
- ☐ SIPMU may sponsor courses in humanistic medicine and psychology aimed at the health professions, conducted by SIPMU members
- ☐ SIPMU, due to its character as a Scientific Society, cannot sponsor courses in which
- For courses not related to hypnosis, lecturers without a degree in the field of health or a degree related to the specific courses are involved.



Each stage of our life poses certain problems or tasks at which we work until faced with the next set of tasks. Some of us solve life's developmental tasks as they arise, some of us take longer; some of us fail and have to put up with a less than optimal existence, and here arise the psychological distress.

We carry distress in adulthood through our childhood memories of the outer world. According to Sir Sahab Ji Maharaj (1935), "This science (the science of psychology) teaches us that every new baby on arrival in this world finds it, as has been aptly put by Professor William James, a 'big, booming and buzzing confusion '. Parents, teachers and other helpers assist the child in clearing this confusion and in harnessing his powers to definite lines of action.

(...) So assisted, the child builds and inner world of his own which of course has to be so constructed as to fit into the needs of the outer world. Now, the outer world, over which we have no control, forces its demands on us ceaselessly during every moment of our existence which naturally entails a severe strain on our powers. The moment we fail to meet any of its demands, we are ruthlessly punished with dissatisfaction, disease, pain and misery. We hate these punishments and try our best to avoid them. But how many of us do really succeed in the attempt, it is difficult to say ".

But, if we succumb to the needs of the outer world psychological disturbances and distressing conditions make a permanent dwelling inside us. In fact, our psychological state is normally characterized by continual disturbances of varying degrees of severity. Some of the common disturbances are fear, anxiety, depression, insecurity, restlessness, frustration, anger, jealousy, suspicion, etc. Constant chatter and distractability of the mind, the perpetual hankering for different objects of desire, the recurrent pull of inertia, etc. are felt by more and more people as states that mar inner well-being which dente a lack of mental health.

(...) Thus, we see that our autonomic nervous system (ANS) is continually mobilized to help us deal with the interpersonal and impersonal stresses we encounter. How can we calm down and reverse the autonomic mobilization from sympathetic dominance to parasympathetic dominance. Sympathetic dominance is the basis of psychosomatic disorders whereas there's meditative calm during parasympathetic dominance.

"Yoga may have something valuable to offer. For yoga is a psychological approach which aims at a radical change of consciousness so as to lead to a state of immutable and unconditioned peace, freedom and joy. The perfect yogic state has been described as not only free from all disturbances, but also immune to them by virtue of its positive characteristics". (A.S. Dalal). "The ease and peace are felt very deep and far within because they are in the psychic and the psychic is very deep within us, covered by the mind and vital. When you meditate you open to the psychic, become aware of your psychic consciousness deep within and feel these things. In order that these ease and peace and happiness may become strong and stable and felt in all the being and in the body, you have to go still deeper within and bring out the full force of the psychic into the physical. This can more easily be done by regular concentration and meditation with the aspiration for this true consciousness. It can be done by work also, by dedication, by doing the work for the Divine only without thought of self". (Sri Aurobindo)

(...) Practice of meditation satisfies all the requirements of 'self-actualization needs' as has been described in the Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs Theory.

Meditation and Self-suggestion (self-hypnosis) are both techniques that can help improve our mental state. "Hypnosis and meditation concern bodily relaxation. Both conditions are states of consciousness achieved by induction procedures that improve relaxation, with corresponding physiological effects. Both hypnosis and meditation show a reduction in sympathetic responses and an increase in parasympathetic tone". (Tung and Hsieh, 2019; Fernandez et al.,2021)

"Coue was a doctor. He used to treat by psychological treatment, autosuggestion, and he called this the true working of imagination; and what he defined as imagination was faith. Imagination is a power of formation. People who have no imagination are not formative from the mental point of view, they cannot give a concrete power to their thought. Imagination is a very powerful means of action. And so he treated all his patients in this way: they had to make a kind of imaginative formation which consisted in thinking themselves cured or in any case on the way to being cured, and in repeating this formation to themselves with sufficient persistence for it to have its effect. He had very remarkable results. He cured lots of people ". (The Mother)






